MINUTE entry before the Honorable Young B. Kim: Receiver's second motion for approval of fee allocations for interim payment [1321] is granted in the amount of \$280,866.92 ("Approved Amount"). For the reasons stated during the June 15, 2023 motion hearing and in this court's previous rulings on the objections to the first allocation motion, the Institutional Lenders' objections, (R. 1442; R. 1443), are overruled. Based on this court's review of the relevant exhibits ——Exhibits A–C to the motion and Exhibits 3 and 4 to the objections---the court rules that the Receiver and his team members have expended a great level of attention and resources to adhere to the court–approved protocol for interim payment of fees and have allocated the approved fees to the right property accounts to the extent possible and as efficiently as possible.
